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Rainy Day - Activities

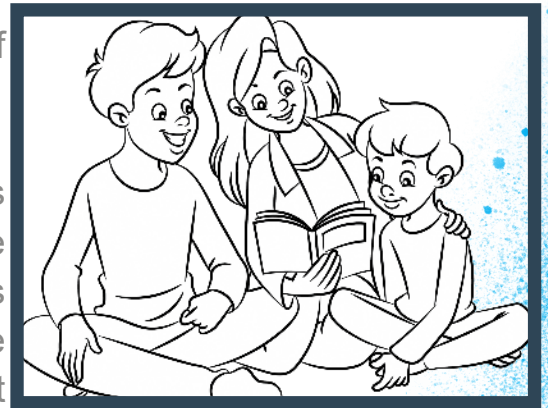
A rainy summer day in a town or city offers plenty of opportunities for fun and entertainment.

At Home

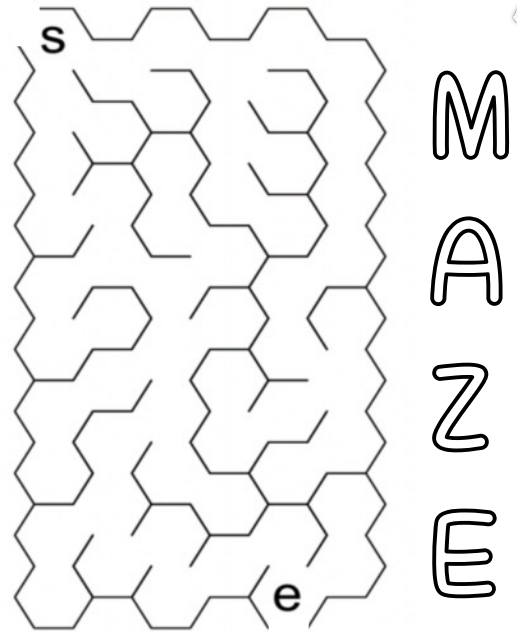
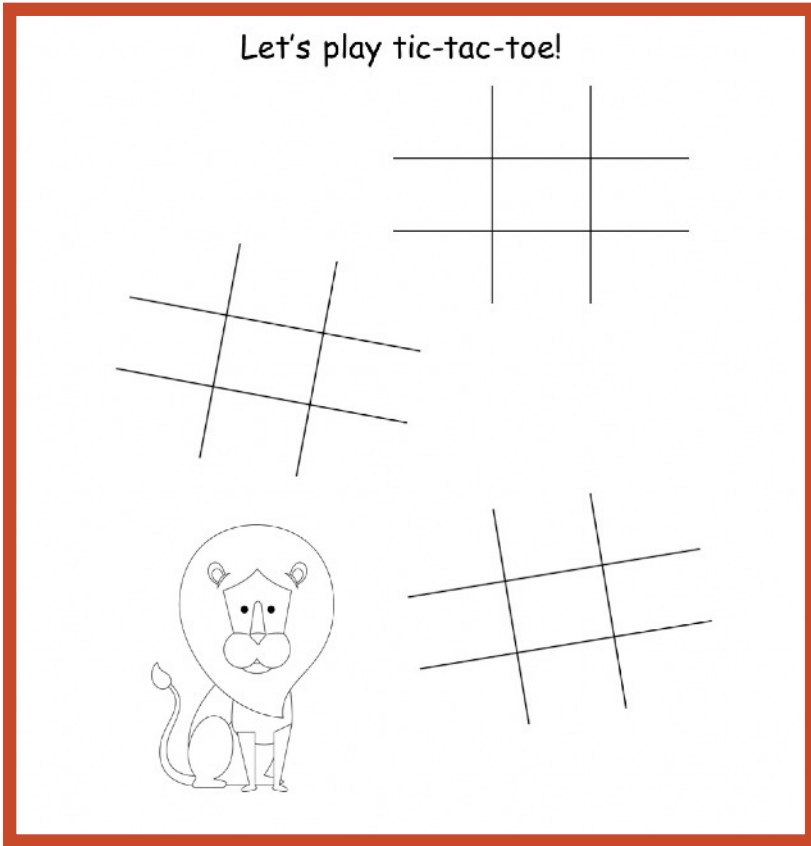
Host a game day with friends or family. Board games and card games are perfect for indoor fun.

Tic Tac Toe, also known as Noughts and Crosses, is a two-player game.

The aim is to be the first player to get three of your symbols (either X or O) in a row, either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

There are two players: one uses X and the other uses

O. The game is played on a 3x3 grid.

Decide who will be X and who will be O. The player with X usually goes first.

Starting the Game:
One player is chosen to go first (usually X).

Players take turns. On each turn, a player places their symbol (X or

O) in an empty square on the grid.

A player wins by placing three of their symbols in a row.

The row can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal.

Draw:
If all nine squares are filled and no player has three in a row, the game ends in a draw.

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Whether you are on a road trip, in a plane, camping or at home, you can play I Spy. Change the letters out for colours for anyone who does not read, or for pictures of common items in the place you will be playing.
